Programme aim

The module is offered in association with the Gaelic Athletic Association (GAA). The aim of this module is to compliment the values of the organisation, assist it's managers and coaches in learning new ways of managing and leading in a sporting context and support its future leadership.

The programme has been carefully constructed to acknowledge and develop the leadership and management skills required by those involved in team management and leadership roles in a dynamic sporting environment.

What is the programme about?

- Demonstrate and apply knowledge of leadership and management
- Appraise and select good one-to-one coaching skills
- Integrate the key concepts of Emotional Intelligence/ Self Awareness in the role of leader/ manager
- Appraise team norms and dynamics and display an ability to manage and lead within sport
- Evaluate and display key elements of self-care and player welfare
- Develop a vision and personal philosophy as a manager/ coach

Assessment

Assessment will be through a combination of reflective journals, yearly development plan, practical walk-through exercises and a presentation.

Entry level requirements

Applicants will come through the GAA. All students on this programme will be required to have a Level 6 qualification.

Applicants without a Level 6 can apply using the Recognition of Prior Learning route and will be considered on a case by case basis.
